Anyone wanting to help with this project can come to room 9A at the Courthouse on Fridays at 10 a.m. where we are processing Vernon County Circuit Court Records from the 1800s to be microfilmed and indexed through a cooperative project with the Missouri State Archives and the Vernon County Circuit Court Clerk.

Printing Census Images on Ancestry.com

When using Ancestry.com for census research, print the census page by using the print icon near the right side of the screen (do not use the File drop-down menu print function). If the census page is wider than it is tall (use "Fit Image" in the sizing box), you can select Landscape Orientation in the Properties of the Print window.
